Maximilian Kolbe

Kolbe was born in Zdunska-Wola, Poland, in 1894. He came from a poor Catholic family and his parents were weavers. His parents taught Raymond to love Jesus, that Jesus was his friend. Raymond worked hard at school he especially loved maths and science. He was interested in space travel and designed a space rocket. This was long before any such thing existed.

He thought and prayed about his life; should he be a scientist or not. Eventually he knew that God was asking him to follow him in a special way. He joined the Franciscans and took the name of Maximilian. He was ordained as a priest in 1918.
