Give reasons for certain actions by believers as they wait in joyful expectation of Advent and Christmas.

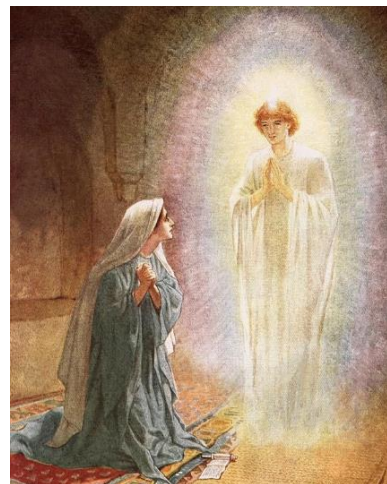
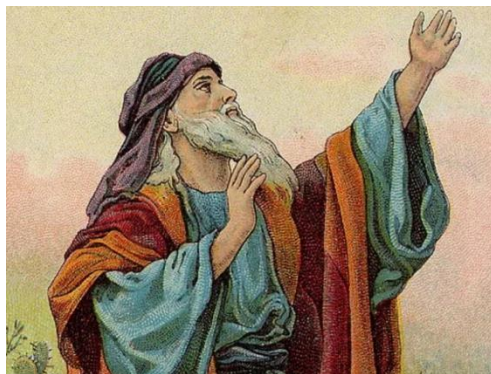
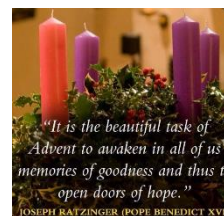
